CONTESTS COMING UP

We are in the middle of contest season and two popular contests are of interest to our members. The ARRL Sweepstakes Phone is this weekend, Saturday, November 18. The event starts at 4PM and runs until 10PM on Sunday. This involves a complicated exchange, consisting of serial number, category, callsign, year first licensed and ARRL section. Be sure to see the Sweepstakes rules to know what to send. As an example, for my 50 th contact I would exchange 50 U W1SJ 69 VT. Of course you have to copy all this information from each station correctly to get credit, so it is challenging. Several hours in this event will certainly make you a better operator!

The 10 Meter Contest is the weekend of December 9th. The event starts Friday evening at 7PM and runs until 7PM on Sunday. The big time for activity is during the daylight hours, but openings can occur at night as well. This one is a lot easier – just give RST and state. With the sunspots heating up, this should be quite an activity.

Be sure to set aside some time to get in on these super events.

Yesterday evening (10/6 after dinner), I was working JA (Japan) stations one after the other on 10 Meters FT8. In fact, I worked 23 of them, most in a row.
